

PSS Electric Vehicle Maritime Safety Conference

17 October 2024

Lithium-ion batteries are increasing used in everyday life, from electric cars to mobility scooters, up to electric tugs and port plant equipment. Whilst the risk of fire associated with their use is not thought to be higher than any other fire risk, the implications of electric battery fires can be far more severe. Dealing with a lithium-ion fire in a port or on a ship presents unique challenges and risks, this conference will discuss those risk and how best to prepare for them.

PSS will be highlighting the risks and mitigations arising from the increased use of electric vehicles in ports and their carriage on vessels transiting through UK ports, across a week of campaigning running from 14 to 18 October 2024. The highlight of the week will be the Electric Vehicle Maritime Safety Conference, in collaboration with the Chamber of Shipping taking place on **Thursday 17** in London.

This conference will bring together experts from academia, the automotive and maritime industries, to discuss the risks and mitigations arising from the increased use of electric vehicles in ports and their transportation on ferries and car carriers. Panel discussions will debate the level of emergency preparedness in UK maritime and what best practice looks like.

The conference presents a unique opportunity for training providers, manufacturers and consultants who support fire prevention, risk management and emergency preparedness to exhibit and present to the audience.
